## DISTANCE LEARNING GUIDES AND INSTRUCTIONS OCTOBER 2020

### 1. Distance education is valid for all years of high school according to the regulation of the Czech Government issued on 12/10/2020 and it is valid from 14/10/2020 to 1/11/2020

- all classes of the 4-year field of education
- all classes of the 8-year higher education

### 2. **Distance learning - principles, structure, rules**

- according to the new wording of the Education Act, this method of teaching is compulsory for all pupils
- the absence must be duly excused by legal guardians or directly by adult pupils
- all the above classes follow the proper schedule and its adjustments according to the weekly schedule - Bakalář
- **teaching takes place via the G-Suite platform (Gmail, Google Classroom, Google Disc, Google Meets)**
- There are basically two types of online lessons

A / **synchronous** = direct online teaching with the teacher through Google Meets, the student is timely and properly connected to the teaching group and actively participates in teaching

B / **asynchronous** = indirect online teaching with a teacher who is ready online to respond to students' questions about the assigned task, students work individually or in groups on the assigned task

- the teacher clearly determines which lessons are synchronous and which asynchronous.
- the condition is that at least one lesson of a given subject per week is always synchronous
- Pupils will always be given a task to work out with a given deadline. The presence of a student in an asynchronous online lesson is considered to be fulfilled if the proper elaboration of the given task according to the assignment
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and its proper submission by the deadline specified by the teacher. Otherwise, the student's absence will be marked in the class book.

Due to the nature of the task, students will have enough time to work the task out and submit it. They just have to work responsibly and actively, as if they were in school. They certainly use a modified schedule and time space for offline teaching (= individual work on the assigned task).

Pupils will be provided with feedback in the form of online consultations and comments.

- absence - must be excused according to the School Rules. As in the case of full-time teaching, this absence in distance learning will be considered and included in the total 25% tolerance of absence in the subject. If the absence in the given subject at the end of the semester is above 25%, it can be classified as non-assessment in the subject and the student will be commissioned

The purpose is not to overwhelm the students with tasks, but to give them meaningful work so that together we can continue to fulfill the School Educational Program and its outputs and successfully and efficiently implement them in the following weeks.

All teachers carry out distance learning at school, coordinating together so that the number of synchronous online lessons is balanced and meaningful every day. Teachers can implement their online lessons from their cabinets or available classrooms.

Teachers duly enroll everything in the class book as in full-time teaching.
